Policy V3 2024

The policy sets out how 'Tactical Security Options Ltd' employees should carry out their activities with regard to Manual Handling

It is 'Tactical Security Options Ltd' aim to comply with The Manual Handling Operations Regulations 1992 (as amended) to avoid hazardous manual handling as far as reasonably practicable; assess the risk of injury from any such tasks that cannot be avoided; and introduce measures to reduce these risks as far as reasonably practicable.

It is 'Tactical Security Options Ltd' policy to:

Ensure that staff are protected from the risk of injury through manual handling.

Eliminate the need for hazardous manual handling where it is reasonably practicable to do so.

Assess and reduce risk of injury arising from manual handling operations that cannot be avoided.

Assess the requirements for manual handling during the provision of 'Tactical Security Options Ltd' product or service.

Implement control measures including information, instruction and training to achieve the above.
